

Water Color / Plein Air Supplies

Palette - for mixing and storing paint

Board and masking tap

Water container

Tissues or paper towels

Drawing pencil and eraser

Optional: spray container, artist sponge, salt

Watercolor paper or watercolor pad - 140 lb. cold press

Watercolor brushes, S M L (for example, # 2, 8, 14 round or ultra round Loew-

Cornell brand. Also a large brush for making washes - I use a brush named Goliath.)

Transparent watercolor paint in tubes: (Tube paint are more expensive. Get a few at a time.)

Watercolor paint (Names of color in tubes):

Blues - Cerulean, Cobalt, Ultramarine blue, Cerulean

Yellows - Lemon, Naples, Cad yellow

Reds - Alizarin Crimson, Scarlet lake, Opera, Cad. Red, Indian Red

Greens - Olive Green, Sap Green, Hooker's Green

Oranges - Cadmium Orange, Brilliant Orange

Purples - Mauve, Purple lake, Permanent Violet

Browns and darks Burnt Sienna, Burnt Umber, Raw Sienna, Sepia, VanDyke brown
