2. To show you are a resident of the county you are applying in:

 - ✓ Address Verification - Utility Bill, or Mail, or Letter
3. Proof that you registered at www.caljobs.ca.gov :
You can also register at your first appointment at the AJCC, they will provide you with access to a computer.
 - ✓ Steps to register at CAL-JOBS website:
 - Log on to the CAL-JOBS website, www.caljobs.ca.gov
 - Once you are on the website, click on the "**Not Registered Yet?**" button (located on the top-right-hand corner)
 - Click "**Individual**"
 - Click "**I Agree**"
 - Enter your information. It will take about 20 minutes.
 - Complete the "**Registration and Resume**" sections the best you can.

 - ✓ Register or show proof that you registered in the Selective Service at www.sss.gov
5. **ONLY IF YOU ARE RECEIVING ANY PUBLIC ASSISTANCE -.**

 - ✓ Letter or Notice of Action – Showing the amount you receive from General Relief, GAIN, GRET, Food Stamps, Cal-Fresh, TANF, Dept. of Social Services, DPSS, Dept. of Mental Health, Dept. of Rehabilitation, Dept. of Veteran's Affairs, etc.
 - ✓ Medi-Cal or Medi-Care Card
 - ✓ Contact information for your caseworker.

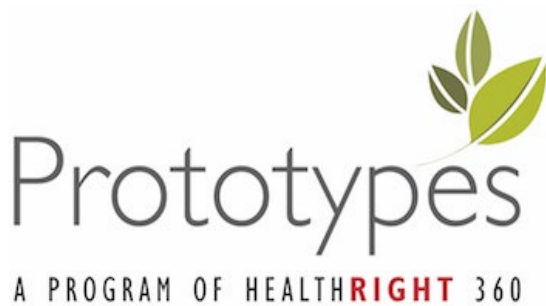

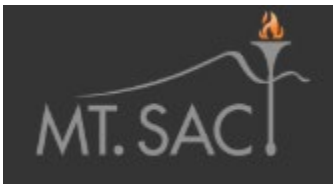

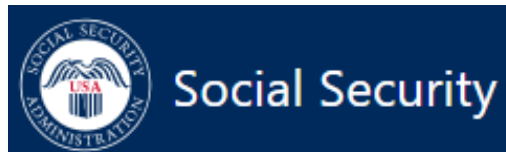
